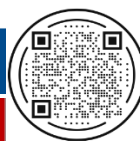

Winter Driving Tips:

- Match your speed to the road and weather conditions
- Avoid passing other vehicles when weather and road conditions are poor. If there is snow or slush between lanes, safely changing lanes is harder
- Many winter holidays include parties that serve alcohol or cannabis products. Only drive if you have not consumed these products.
- Remove all the snow from your vehicle including on the hood, roof, windows, and lights. Clear all windows of frost and fog. This can help you see better on the road and prevent snow from sliding onto your windshield or on to other cars while you drive.
- Drive with your headlights on
- Bulky winter coats and snow suits do not work well when it comes to your child's car seat. Make sure your child is wearing lighter winter clothing so they can be properly buckled in their car seat with a snug harness and bring an extra blanket to place over them to keep them warm

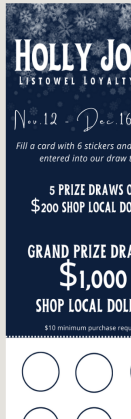

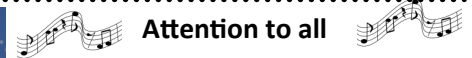
