#### Advanced Aquatics Atwood Lions Pool: July 14 - 18, 2025

#### **Bronze Star:**

#### Cost: \$145 8 a.m. - 12 p.m.

Excellent preparation for success in Bronze Medallion. Participants develop problem-solving and decision-making skills individually and in partners. Candidates learn CPR and develop the lifesaving skills needed to become a lifeguard. Includes a timed 400m swim.

#### Bronze Medallion and Emergency First Aid & CPR:

#### Cost: \$242 8 a.m. - 3 p.m.

Teaches an understanding of the lifesaving principles embodied in the 4 components of water-rescue education – judgment, knowledge, skill, and fitness. Rescuers learn tows and carries, and defense methods and releases in preparation for challenging rescues of increased risk involving conscious and unconscious victims of various types. Lifesavers develop stroke efficiency and endurance in a 500m timed swim. A Bronze Medallion is the prerequisite for the Lifesaving Bronze Cross. Must be a minimum of 13 years of age.

#### **Bronze Cross and Standard First Aid & CPR**

#### Cost: \$242 8 a.m. - 3 p.m.

Designed for lifesavers who want the challenge of more advanced training, including an introduction to safe supervision in aquatic facilities. Bronze Cross is a pre-requisite for all advanced training programs including National Lifeguard (NLS) and Water Safety Instructor certification (WSI). Includes a timed 600m swim.


